

## ECTS Grading Table

### Master of International Communication

This ECTS Grading Table is based on all numerical test results obtained by students of the Master of International Communication programme between 1 September 2017 and 1 September 2020. The numerical test results represent 100 % of all test results awarded to the students in this programme in the abovementioned period.

In the Dutch grading system, 5.5 is the lowest pass grade and 10 is the highest possible grade.
