Nomination period	Autumn semester: 15 March – 15 May Spring semester: 15 September - 15 October
Online application procedure	Students need to apply online in Osiris and upload the required documents. Application details: www.hanze.nl/applicationexchange
Application period	Autumn semester: 15 April – 1 June Spring semester: 15 September - 1 November

Semester dates	Autumn Semester: September – February Spring Semester: February – July The academic calendar can be found on the website.
Welcome Day	At the start of each semester we organise a Welcome Day for all new international students. On this day students will receive information about important practical matters. Accepted students will receive an invitation by email.
Registration Day	For students with a non-European nationality we also organise a Registration Day for immigration purposes. We urge Non EU students to attend!
Language of instruction	The language of instruction is English.
English language requirements	Exchange students are not required to submit proof of their English proficiency. Partner institutions are expected to select students who have a good standard of English (minimum of B2/CEFR)
Possibility of attending courses from different departments	Students can only apply for an exchange programme with a <i>Hanze School</i> as stated in the institutional agreement. Most <i>Schools</i> offer fixed semester programmes (30 ECTS). It is not possible to ‘mix and match’ courses from different <i>Schools</i> .
Learning Agreements	Learning Agreements will be approved by the <i>School</i> . The International Service Desk cannot help with courses
