Most of the time, exchange students coming to our university, choose the blocks at the 2<sup>nd</sup> level (= 2<sup>nd</sup> year). Each block consists of a set of various "fixed" units. If you choose a block, you will need to take all the units that are part of that block. This means that it is not possible, for instance, to choose units from 3 or 4 different blocks. Instead, you need to choose one or two blocks from which all units are required.

There is flexibility in the blocks you can choose. You can combine e.g. a first year block with a second year block. So, there are various options to compose a customised exchange semester!

The level 3 courses (ISDS) and the Minor/Exchange Programme is one full semester and cannot be split up!
