Healthy Ageing

Healthy Ageing, adding healthy life years, is one of the strategic themes of the Hanze University of Applied Sciences (Hanze UAS). Changes in society, the care system, the rise of technology and e-Health require a different approach to health and new competencies for the professional. Hanze UAS anticipates this development by means of education and research in collaboration with industrial partners and institutions.

The **Centre of Expertise Healthy Ageing** combines research, education and entrepreneurship in the field of Healthy Ageing. The **School of Health Care Studies** offers education in the field of allied health care and nursing.

The **professorship Healthy Ageing, Allied Health Care and Nursing** coordinates and performs applied scientific research in the domain of allied health care and nursing. In order to reinforce our Healthy Ageing education and research, visiting professor Faith Ottery will be appointed to the professorship Healthy Ageing, Allied Health Care and Nursing and the School of Health Care Studies.

Malnutrition research and education

Healthy Ageing is one of the most important challenges of societies in general as well for individuals. However, at older age many people experience functional decline and frailty, which may contribute to care dependency. A key issue in the complex process of frailty and functional decline is nutritional status. It is estimated that about half of all hospitalized elderly patients suffer from malnutrition. In patients aged 80 years or above the prevalence is even higher. Adequate screening, assessment and proactive treatment of malnutrition are therefore needed.

Prof. Faith Ottery defined the concepts of nutritional oncology, anabolic synergy, and anabolic competence and has written extensively and lectured both nationally and internationally in nutritional oncology and nutritional assessment. Prof. Faith Ottery is well known internationally as the developer of the Scored Patient-Generated Subjective Global Assessment (PG-SGA), which has become the standard of nutritional assessment in oncology patients. Together with Prof. Harriët Jager-Wittenaar she further developed the PG-SGA into a digital format, which is now available as the Pt-Global app. Prof. Faith Ottery participated in the research line Clinical Malnutrition and Healthy Ageing.

Allied health care professionals and nurses should be aware of the central role of malnutrition and its relation with frailty, functional decline, quality of life, oral health status etc. Therefore interdisciplinary education about malnutrition will be further developed for students and professionals.

Curriculum Vitae

Prof. Faith Ottery is Global Medical Director of Biologics, at Hospira, a Pfizer Company, Lake Forest, USA, and President of Ottery & Associates, LLC, greater Chicago area, USA. Prof. Ottery is an Honorary Fellow with faculty status at the Native American Center for Healthcare Professionals, University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health, Madison, Wisconsin, USA.

Prof. Ottery trained in medical oncology, trained and practiced as a surgical oncologist and also has her doctorate in Nutritional Sciences. From 1988-1995 Prof. Ottery was Adjunct Assistant Professor at Temple University, and from 1987-1994 she was Director of the Nutrition Support Service at Fox Chase Cancer Center.

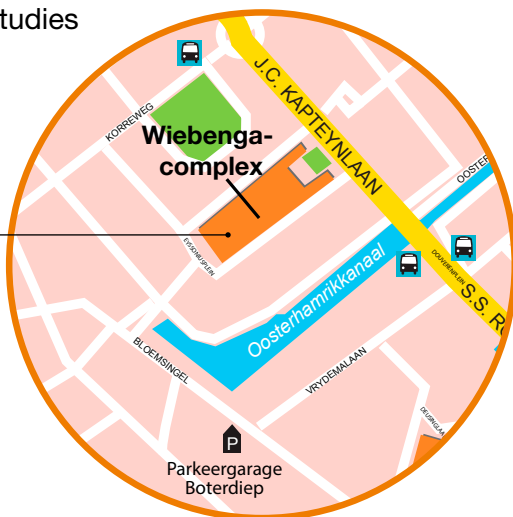
