You are allowed to link to a lawfully published work from Blackboard. This also includes links to databases of Hanze Library or Hanze.WorldCat.

Is the excerpt an Open Access article and/or does it contain a Creative Commons (CC) licence?

Inclusion in reader or on Blackboard is allowed.
Usage does not involve payment or report to Stichting UvO . When using, please mention:

- that it is an Open Access publication
- the author has given permission
- the source reference

Does the excerpt originate from a publisher which has specifically authorised such use in its licence conditions?

Upload on Blackboard is allowed under the publisher's permission. This also applies to a number of databases of Hanze Library. See [A-Z database](#) list for permitted use information

Upload on Blackboard is allowed depending on the agreement made by Hanze UAS or you with the publisher and/or other rightholders.

Is it a brief excerpt?

Upload on Blackboard is allowed.

Hanze UAS pays a lump sum for brief excerpts. Include a reference (title, author(s), publisher, ISBN/ISSN (if known)).

If you want to use a long excerpt, you have to apply for permission with [Stichting UvO](#) or the publisher beforehand (10 days before use). You need permission from your manager; the School pays a fee per page per student.

Note:

A bundling of excerpts is seen as a (digital) reader, which should be reported!

Conditions brief excerpt:

- *Texts, sheet music, etcetera:*
max. 50 pages, but not more than 1/4 of the publication;
- *Graphs, tables, diagrams, photos and illustrations:*
max. 50, but no more than 25 from an original work or 10 from one maker
