

Instructions for the intake assessment

The intake assessment

- will be held online or at the Minerva Academy of Pop Culture in Leeuwarden
- will take no more than 30 minutes
- will involve three assessors: two teaching staff and one student
- will look at the portfolio comprising your own work and the assignments (see 'Instructions on producing your portfolio')

What will you be assessed on?

Your portfolio (own work) is key to the intake assessment. Your own development, personality and motivation play a significant role on the course, so an interview covering why you want to follow the course is an essential aspect of the intake assessment. You will be assessed on the basis of the assessment form that can be downloaded from the website.

How will you be invited?

You will receive an invitation to the intake assessment one week beforehand. This invitation will state where and when the intake assessment is to be held. Intake assessment dates are specified on Hanze University of Applied Sciences Groningen's website.

How will you be informed of the outcome?

A decision on whether or not to accept or reject your application will be made on the basis of your portfolio and the criterion-based interview. Final decisions on the intake portfolio assessments will be communicated by telephone on the subsequent Tuesday.
